Peter Ingelse has a wide range of experience: he worked (in chronological order) as a researcher at the Universities of Groningen and Amsterdam, as an attorney, as a judge for the Amsterdam District Court and as a judge for the Amsterdam Court of Appeal. He served as the vice-president of the Amsterdam Court of Appeal since 2001. For several years, he was the president of the preliminary relief unit at the Amsterdam Court of Appeal and from August 2009 until May 2015, he was president of the Enterprise Court (Ondernemingskamer) of the Amsterdam Court of Appeal. From 2015 until mid 2025 he worked as a mediator/arbitrator/binding advisor with ReulingSchutte, Amsterdam.

During his long career as a lawyer and a judge, Peter Ingelse has gained a wide range of dispute resolution experience, not just through adjudicating disputes at law, but also through his involvement in consulting on, negotiating and arranging amicable settlements. He used that experience in his work as a mediator, arbitrator and binding advisor. He focused on business mediations, primarily commercial disputes and disputes between legal entities and partnerships, such as those between shareholders, between bodies within a legal entity and between works councils and legal entities.
